FAIR PLAY POLICY

Adopted by BoT November 2003

Reviewed on a 4-yearly cycle – last review June 2015

Rationale

To promote the desirable behaviour of players, officials, coaches, parents and supporters and create an understanding that Fair Play is an expectation in our school and community. Good sport is always about positive attitude.

Purposes

- To recognise individuals and teams exhibiting fair play in sport.
- To involve parents, players, officials, coaches and supporters in fair play practices.
- To promote fair play within the whole school environment.

Guidelines

1. The Fair Play policy will be reinforced as much as possible: individuals and teams who play hard and fair will be recognised.
2. [Fair Play Codes of Conduct](#) for sports team members, parents, and coaches will be issued when sports teams are organised. Students are expected to “Play hard but play fair”; “Give it heaps but don’t get ugly”.
3. Players and parents will be addressed in team meetings, coaches’ meetings and via the school newsletter. Fair play will be expected from everybody involved.
4. Inappropriate behaviour will be dealt with. Coaches and staff will seek school support and advice. A player may be stood down by the school if deemed necessary.
5. In order to help the wider school community to understand our Fair Play policy a Parent and Spectators’ Code of Conduct will be published on the School website and annually in the School newsletter.

Conclusion: Fair Play is all about positive attitude and the environment we create for the children to experience personal challenge and success.
